



HALO BEANIE

This simple beanie with a ribbed brim is worked in the round.
Make it as long or as short as you like to create an ultimate
quick staple accessory for cold weather season!





Sizes

1 (2, 3, 4)

Child (Adult-Small, Adult-Large, Adult-Extra Large)

To fit head circumference

20-21 (21-22, 22-24, 24-26)" / 51-53.5 (53.5-56, 56-61, 61-66) cm

Finished Measurements

(blocked)

Brim Circumference 12¾ (14½, 16, 17½)" / 32.5 (37, 40.5, 44.5) cm

Hat Body Circumference 18¼ (20½, 22¾, 25)" / 46.5 (52, 58, 63.5) cm

Length 9¼ (9½, 9¾, 10¼)" / 23 (24, 25, 26) cm

Notes

If you wish to alter beanie's height/depth you can work more or fewer plain rnds before crown shaping.

Materials

- De Rerum Natura "Cyrano" (100% wool); approx. 164 yds (150 m) per 3.5 oz (100 g);
 - Solid color: 1 ball;
 - Two-color: 1 ball for MC, 1 ball for CC.

Size 2 shown in color "Plume".

Size 3 shown in colors "Goeland" and "Argile".

- Spincycle Yarns "Plump" (100% superwash American wool; 100 yds / 91.5 m per approx. 100 g / 3.4 oz); 1 (2, 2, 2) skeins;

Size 1 shown in color "Valley Girl".

Size 4 shown in color "Under the Wave".

OR approx. 95 (114, 124, 135) yds / 87 (104, 113, 123) m for solid color hat or 48 (57, 62, 68) yds / 44 (52, 57, 62) m for MC and 48 (57, 62, 68) yds / 44 (52, 57, 62) m for CC for striped two-color hat in any other Bulky / Chunky weight yarn with similar properties

Yardage listed includes 10% padding for swatching

- US#9 (5.5 mm) circular 16" / 40.5 cm or a set of 5 dpns (for ribbing)
- US#11 (8 mm) circular 16" / 40.5 cm and a set of 5 dpns (or other preferred method for working small circumferences in the rnd) (for hat body) OR use size to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers
- Tapestry needle

Gauge

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in 1x1 Ribbing worked on smaller size needle, measured once dry after washing and blocking.

14 sts and 18 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st worked on larger size needle, measured once dry after washing and blocking.

Abbreviations

- BO - bind off
- BOR - beginning of row
- CC - contrasting color
- CO - cast on
- k - knit
- k2tog - knit 2 sts together (right-leaning knit decrease)
- LN - left needle
- m -marker
- MC - main color
- p - purl
- rem - rem(ain/ing)
- rep - repeat
- RN - right needle
- sl - slip
- ssk - slip, slip, knit (left-leaning knit decrease)
- st(s) - stitch(es)

Directions

Brim

Using Long-tail method and smaller size needle, CO 64 (72, 80, 88) sts with work (MC) yarn. Check alignment of the sts so they are not twisted. Place unique m to indicate BOR.

Solid Color Ribbing:

Rib Rnds 1-11: Sl BOR m, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Or work Ribbing Rnds until brim measures approx. 2" / 5 cm including CO.

Two-Color / Striped Ribbing:

Rnds 1-3 (MC): Sl BOR m, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnds 4-7 (CC): Sl BOR m, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Rnds 8-11 (MC): Sl BOR m, *k1, p1; rep from * to end.

Resume with larger size needle

Solid Hat Body:

Continue work in St st (knit every round) until the body of the hat (without ribbing) measures approx. 4¾ (4¾, 4½, 4½)" / 12 (12, 11.5, 11.5) cm or approx. 22 (22, 20, 20) rnds.

Two-Color/Striped Hat Body:

Rnds 1-4 (CC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnds 5-8 (MC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnds 9-12 (CC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnds 13-16 (MC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnds 17-20 (CC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Sizes 1-2 only:

Rnds 21-22 (MC): Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Continue working in est pattern, if working a Solid Color hat - work in St st, and if working stripes, maintain stripes pattern and **AT THE SAME TIME** work Crown Shaping:

Crown Shaping

Resume with dpns or other preferred method for working smaller circumference in the rnd.

Rnd 1: Sl BOR m, *k 16 (18, 20, 22), pm; rep from * to last 16 (18, 20, 22) sts, k 16 (18, 20, 22).

Rnd 2: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. **56 (64, 72, 80) sts. 8 sts decr'd.**

Rnds 3, 5, 7: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 4: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. **48 (56, 64, 72) sts. 8 sts decr'd.**

Rnd 6: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. **40 (48, 56, 64) sts. 8 sts decr'd.**

Rnd 8: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. **32 (40, 48, 56) sts. 8 sts decr'd.**

Size 1 only:

Rnd 9: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. 24 sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 10: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. 16 sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 11: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. 8 sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Cut yarn, leaving 4" / 10 cm tail.

Size 2 only:

Rnd 9: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 10: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (32, -, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 11: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (24, -, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 12: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (16, -, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 13: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (8, -, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Cut yarn, leaving 4" / 10 cm tail.

Size 3 only:

Rnd 9: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 10: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, 40, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 11: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 12: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, 32, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 13: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, 24, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 14: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, 16, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 15: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, 8, -) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Cut yarn, leaving 4" / 10 cm tail.

Size 4 only:

Rnd 9: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 10: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 48) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 11: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 12: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 40) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 13: Sl BOR m, knit to end.

Rnd 14: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 32) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 15: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 24) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 16: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, k to 2 st before next m, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 16) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Rnd 17: Sl BOR m, *k2tog, ssk, sl m; rep from * to end. - (-, -, 8) sts. 8 sts decr'd.

Cut yarn, leaving 4" / 10 cm tail.

Resume for ALL:

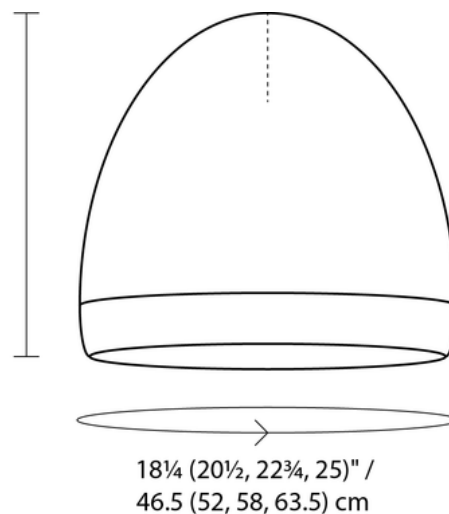
Thread tail through the tapestry needle and pull it through rem 8 sts.

Finishing

Weave the ends, but do not trim them.

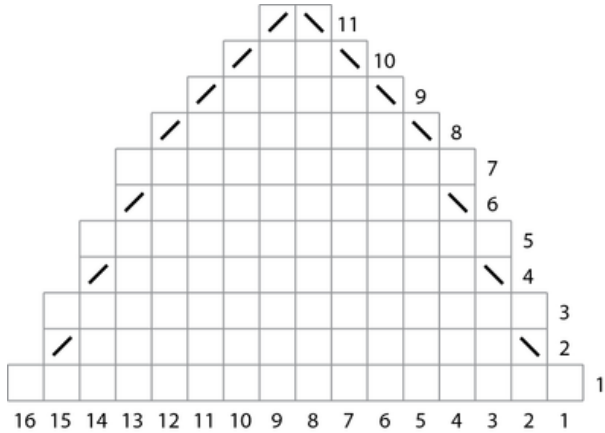
Soak hat in warm water with woolwash. Do not wring, roll into a dry towel to dry. Block to measurements. Once dry, trim ends.

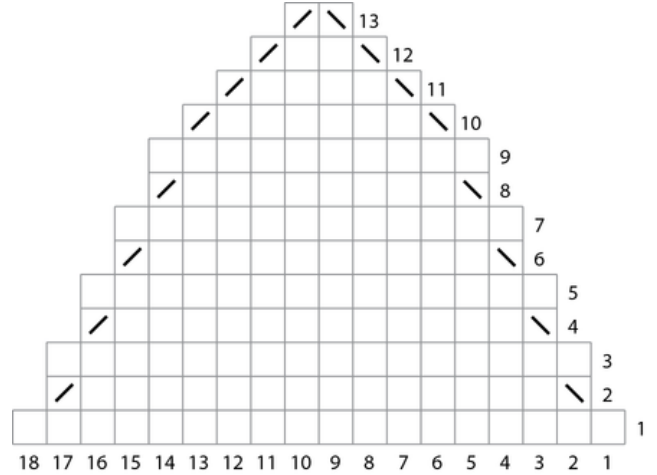


Crown Shaping Charts

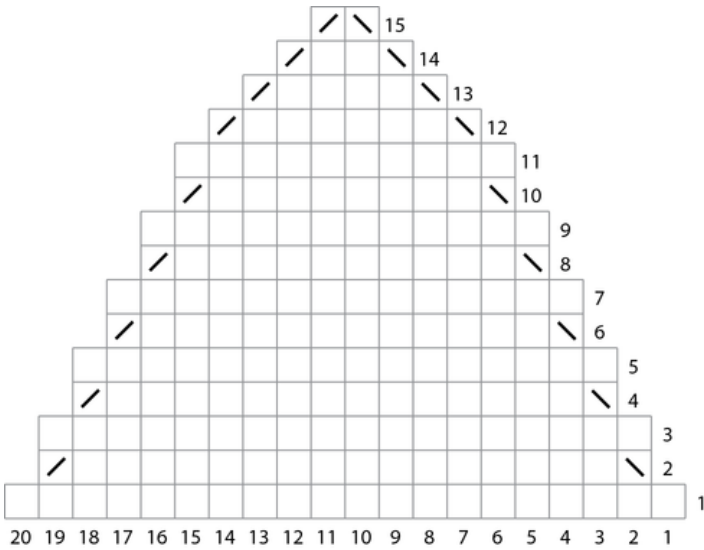
Size 1

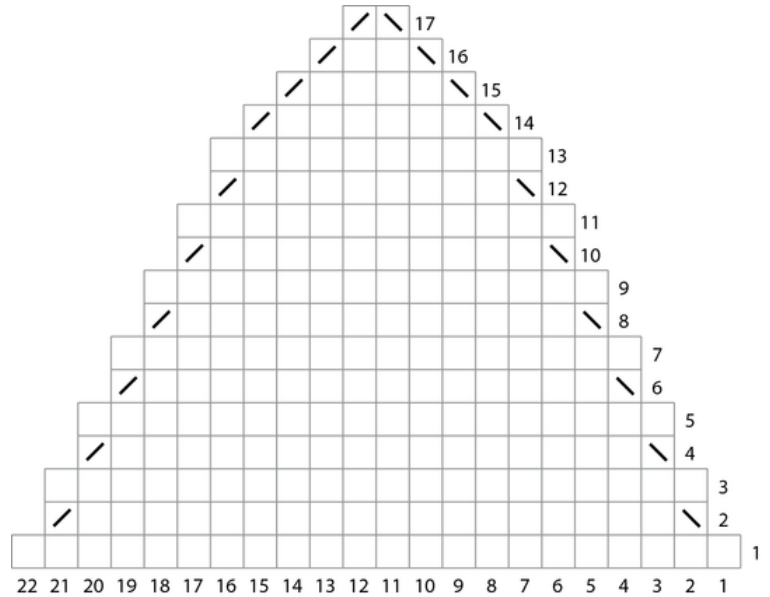


Chart Key
